

Day 11 Anchorage, AK

As we travel South today we will make a stop **Veteran's Memorial** for one more chance to see Mt. McKinley. Then, we will enjoy lunch on our own in Talkeena. From Talkeetna, we head to Willow to visit the **Dream a Dream Dog Farm** operated by South Dakota native, Vern Halter. Next, we visit the **Iditarod** Headquarters as we continue our journey to Anchorage. Upon arrival to Anchorage, we will do a city tour and then we check into our hotel accommodations for the next two nights. (B)

Day 12 Anchorage, AK

After our included breakfast this morning we will travel along Turn-Again Arm today to Whittier and board a boat for our **26 Glacier Cruise** with an included lunch along Prince William Sound. This highlight will enlighten us with many glaciers and icebergs. Our dinner is included tonight at the Sourdough Mining Company. (B,L,D)

Day 13 Home

We enjoy breakfast this morning before boarding our flight back to the Twin Cities, with a coach awaiting our arrival. (B)

Day 1 Flight to Ship

Our journey to the great state of Alaska begins with our flight from Minneapolis to Seattle. Upon our arrival, a motorcoach will be waiting for us to bring us to Vancouver, BC to board Royal Caribbean's *Radiance of the Seas* for a fun-filled five day cruise of the Inside Passage of Alaska. (D)

Day 2 Inside Passage

Today we experience the mountain and coastal scenery of the Inside Passage. This fjord-like waterway remains the vital link between coastal towns. We marvel at the spectacular views of snow-capped mountains, lush forests, and hundreds of islands and inlets. There are many activities to take part in aboard the ship so be sure to check them out. (B, L,D)

Day 3 Ketchikan, AK

Today we will arrive in Ketchikan. Built out over the water and climbing weathered stairways, Ketchikan clings to the shores of Tongass Narrows and drapes the mountains with a cheerful air. You can visit the town on your own today enjoying the totem pole museum, the fish hatchery, or just walking Creek Street. (B,L,D)

Day 4 Icy Strait Point, AK

Icy Strait Point is located near the city of Hoonah, the largest native Tlingit Indian settlement in Alaska, and very near Glacier Bay National Park. Home to a historic cannery, the port's connection to the sea is strong. Locals share the sea with humpback whales, orcas, Dall porpoises, seals, sea otters, halibut and all five species of Pacific salmon. It is not uncommon to spot a humpback or an orca while walking along the shore. (B, L, D)

**Day 5 Juneau, AK**

Located at the foot of grand mountain peaks on the Gastineau Channel, the town of Juneau, the capital city of Alaska, has the massive Mendenhall Glacier and the immense Juneau Icefields at its back door. Juneau is the place to let your imagination run wild. Visit the rustic shops in town. Or get out and kayak, dogsled, raft, hike, whale watch, flightsee or fish. There is no end to the adventure because of the long daylight hours. (B,L,D)

Day 6 Whitehorse, YT

As we cruise the Lynn Canal, we will see glaciers clinging to the mountains. We will arrive in the port city of Skagway where you can walk the wooden boardwalks and see the restored buildings from the gold rush days. Here we will disembark the ship to begin our land portion of the tour. We will board the **White Pass and Yukon Railroad** to ride through the White Mountains following the route that the gold-seekers followed from Skagway to Fraser. Then we will board the motorcoach to travel to our overnight destination of Whitehorse, Yukon. Upon arrival to Whitehorse, we visit such sights as the fish ladder, Old Log Church, Log Cabin Skyscrapers and S.S. Klondike picture stop.. (B)

Day 7 Beaver Creek, YT

We will travel the Alaska Highway today. The highway was built during World War II to connect the lower 48 states to Alaska through Canada. Our accommodations are in Beaver Creek and tonight we are treated to the **Rendezvous Review Dinner and Show**. (B, D)

Day 8 Fairbanks, AK

Again we will travel along the Alaska Highway making stops along the way at the visitor center in Tok, the "final mile" at Delta Junction, and the Alaska pipeline. We will get a view of the Ellison Air Force Base. Next, we stop at the "**North Pole**", and allow some time to shop at the Santa Claus House before reaching our hotel for the next two evenings in Fairbanks. Tonight, we will be treated to an all-you-can-eat **Salmon Bake**, with salmon, ribs and cod. (B, D)

Day 9 Fairbanks, AK

We will board a narrow gauge railway car that will take us to the **Gold Dredge #8** seeing the many ways of finding gold, and then doing some panning for ourselves. After our included lunch, we will board the **Discovery Riverboat** and cruise the Chena and Tanana Rivers. We'll explore the Eskimo cultures and see dog sled demonstrations. (B, L)

**Day 10 Denali, AK**

Traveling south today we enter into **Denali National Park**. We will check into our lodging this afternoon, and then enjoy a guided **wildlife** tour of Denali National Park on one of their special buses. We will learn the history of the park as well as keep a look out for moose, caribou, and bear. (B)
