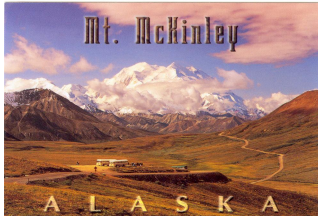


## Highlights Include:

**Day 1 Anchorage**  
We'll arrive in Anchorage today with a Riley motorcoach awaiting our arrival to bring us to our overnight accommodations which will be in downtown Anchorage. As we make our way to our hotel, we will enjoy a **tour of the city of Anchorage**. The rest of the day is at your leisure.

**Day 2 Denali**  
Our morning begins with a visit at the **Iditarod Museum**. We'll make a stop en-route at the **Veteran's Memorial**, hoping to see Mt. McKinley. We'll check into our overnight accommodations and then this afternoon, we will board a special bus for the **Wildlife tour of Denali National Park**. This 6-8 hour tour will give a good opportunity to see bear, moose, caribou, elk, birds, and many small game. This evening, we will enjoy the **Cabin Nite Dinner Theatre**. (B,D)



**Day 3 Fairbanks**  
This morning, we'll drive North to Fairbanks, the city with the golden heart. Upon arrival, we will visit the **University of Alaska Museum** to see its botanical, geological, zoological, and cultural collections. Then, we check into our accommodations for the next two evenings. Tonight, we enjoy ourselves at the **Salmon Bake**, feasting on all-you-can-eat salmon, halibut, and cod. After dinner, we'll walk over to Alaskaland and see the "**Golden Heart Revue**" show, depicting the "golden days" in Fairbanks, in a humorous fashion. (B, D)



**Day 4 Fairbanks**  
Today we begin with a cruise along the Chena and Tanana Rivers on the **Riverboat Discovery**. On this cruise, we'll visit an Eskimo village to learn the many cultures and how they survived. You will experience a dog sled demonstration by the trainer of the late Susan Butcher, a 4-time Iditarod winner. This afternoon, we'll board a narrow gauge railroad car and learn how the **gold mining** was done then and now and what methods they used to survive the below freezing temperatures. Upon arrival to the camp, we'll see demonstrations on mining and then have a chance to pan for some ourselves. (B)



**Day 5 Valdez**  
After breakfast this morning, we depart Fairbanks with our first stop being in **North Pole, Alaska** to visit the Santa Claus House. Next, we'll continue on to Delta Junction, viewing the Alaska pipeline and its suspension over the Tanana River. We'll stop at the visitors center depicting the final mile of the infamous Alaska Highway. We will make a stop at Thompson Glacier before making our way to Valdez for our overnight. (B)



**Day 6-13 Holland America Cruise on the MS Veendam**  
Today we will enjoy a cruise of **Prince William Sound** passing Bligh Reef, where the Exxon Valdez spilled, as well as seeing **Columbia Glacier**. This is more than just a glacier tour as we'll see and float within thousands of icebergs, many larger than the boat we are in, with seals resting on the bergs. Our cruise ends in Whittier where our coach will



meet us to take us to Seward where we will board Holland America's Veendam, to begin our journey along the Inside Pas-

sage of Alaska, into Prince William Sound and the Gulf of Alaska to Glacier Bay National Park. The ports of call we will stop at will be Sitka, Skagway, Juneau, and Ketchikan, with optional tours available at each stop. Every day we will receive a daily schedule of the events happening, such as informational talks on nature along the Inside Passage, as well as optional activities for each port of call. All meals on board the ship are included as well as ship activities. There is a casino on board as well. On the final day, we will arrive into Vancouver in the morning, then board our flight back to the Twin Cities where a motorcoach will be awaiting our arrival. (All meals included for the entire cruise.)
